

# The Energy Insurance and Risk Management Course

# The Energy Insurance Diploma Course

The course provides an introduction to the fundamental principles of insurance, such as insurable interest, indemnity subrogation, contribution, etc. It is particularly suitable for people in their early years of training, or individuals who have transferred from the finance or legal sector into insurance and who requires a broad understanding of the essential principles of insurance before seeking the specialised knowledge of the industry. It is not suitable for individuals who are looking for in-depth training in a specialised branch such as the energy insurance industry. The course is predominately led by an ACII Chartered Insurance Practitioner and other insurance practitioners from the Energy Practice of Marsh. An assessment paper is taken at the end of the course.*

The speakers will consist of insurance practitioners from Energy Practice of Marsh, in addition specialist external speakers, including Risk Finance practitioners and Energy Site Managers'. Knowledge transfer is delivered through formal presentations, workshops, case studies and a site visit. Delegates will be expected to actively participate in a case study and team presentation.

This course offers a foundation of the basic principles of marine insurance is included, with special attention given to the Marine Insurance Act (1906). The speakers will consist of insurance practitioners from our Marine Hull & Liability, Cargo Marine Claims Departments. Knowledge is imparted through formal, but highly interactive presentations and exercises. This course has proved to be so popular that it is now run 4 times annually to cope with demand.

### ***The cost of this course is £1,250 plus VAT, per delegate.***
